Greetings, California and U.S. Youth Soccer Community, In June 2024, we celebrated CYSM's 10th anniversary

My name is Carlos Velasco, and I am the President and Founder of California Youth Sports Management (CYSM). Since our inception in June 2014, CYSM has nurtured young soccer talent and fostered the sport's growth throughout California, particularly in the Central Valley. Our dedication and efforts have led to significant achievements in youth soccer.

From the beginning, CYSM has diligently worked to establish an international youth soccer network, offering our players opportunities to train and compete We actively seek the support of government entities, at elite levels across Europe. Over the past decade, our athletes have traveled to countries including Croatia, Denmark, Italy, Portugal, and Spain.

On the international level, our players have traveled abroad and trained under the guidance of academy coaches from prestigious clubs like GNK Dinamo Zagreb, Real Betis Balompié, Villarreal CF, and RCD Espanyol. They've also competed in renowned tournaments such as Mundialito (Spain), Dana Cup (Denmark), Algarve Youth Cup (Portugal), and San Marino Cup (Italy), among others. Around 400 players have participated in these international experiences, combining high-level soccer competitions with rich cultural exchange. We are excited to continue providing these invaluable opportunities for future generations.

On the local level, CYSM has invested significantly in soccer camps and coaching clinics across California. These programs, led by professional coaches from world-renowned academies like Sport Lisboa Benfica, GNK Dinamo Zagreb, and Real Betis Balompié, aim to expose local players and coaches to top-tier soccer training. Notable coaches such as Quique Setién, former head coach of F.C. Barcelona, and Marcos Álvarez, the current head fitness coach of Chelsea FC, have led our seminars. We aim to ensure that more U.S.-based players and coaches have access to the best expertise in soccer. More than 2,000 boys and girls have participated in our camps statewide.

This groundbreaking event brought together around 1,200 young players from professional academies across Croatia, England, Italy, Mexico, Portugal, Spain, and the U.S. The tournament was a tremendous success, and we are now focused on making the second edition—the California Cup 2025 even bigger and better.

The CYC 2024 provided the city of Fresno and the surrounding cities an opportunity to showcase what the cities can offer our visitors and guests, including the many supporters who flooded the stadiums to watch the games. The positive economic impact is seen in hotels, gas stations, restaurants, bars, food trucks, grocery stores, and rental cars. When most locals go out of town during June when the temperature reaches three digits, CYSM did the opposite by inviting all these teams, players, and visitors, leading to increased spending, which benefits local businesses and franchises. Our local educational institutions, California State University, Fresno, and Fresno City College, also benefited from CYC 2024 through promotions, marketing, and social media presence.
